BACKGROUND: Working on the thought that it is simple to tell yellow from red from blue from green (and so on), WE DO NOT PRINT COLOUR NAMES on the labels. That results in a saving of \$2.00 per bottle in production costs; and of course these savings are passed on to you, our students and customers.

YOUR TASK: To write the colour names on the bottles yourself, as desired!

A simple task, to enjoy the savings !!!

BUT WHERE SOME COLOURS MAY BE TRICKY TO IDENTIFY, THERE ARE A FEW THINGS WE DO TO HELP YOU:

- 1. First up, we suggest you turn the bottle upside down and compare the colour against what you see on the colour chart See the flip side of this page.
- 2. You will know what paints you have ordered from us, so let that also be your guide. Check what you have ordered against what is on your invoice.
- 3. Some paints have a coloured dot on the bottle, if there are three or four of that colour 'type' in our range See notes below.

PAINTS WITH DOTS:

Blue	Same colour as the Blue in our Liquid Radiance range. Pigment name: phthalo blue	Navy is darker than Blue. Ultramarine is lighter than Blue.
Green	Same colour as the Green in our Liquid Radiance range. Pigment name: phthalo green	Teal is more blueish/whitish
Purple	Clear purple, often thought of as Royal Purple (or Cadbury Purple!)	
Genesis Purple	So called as it is our business colour. It is generally known as aubergine (mix of red and purple.)	Burgundy is more red that Genesis Purple. Chocolate is darker than milk chocolate but lighter than 70% dark choc. Caramel is just that – yummy yellowish brown.
Eucalypt	Mid-yellowish green	Olive is darker – almost black when you see it in the bottle. Sage is grey green, the colour of the herb after which it was named.

ALL FLAT PAINTS and ADDITIVES have a Dark Purple square on their label.

Anything with that Purple letter on its label can be mixed with anything else with the Purple on its label

to create whatever colour or painted effect you wish.
