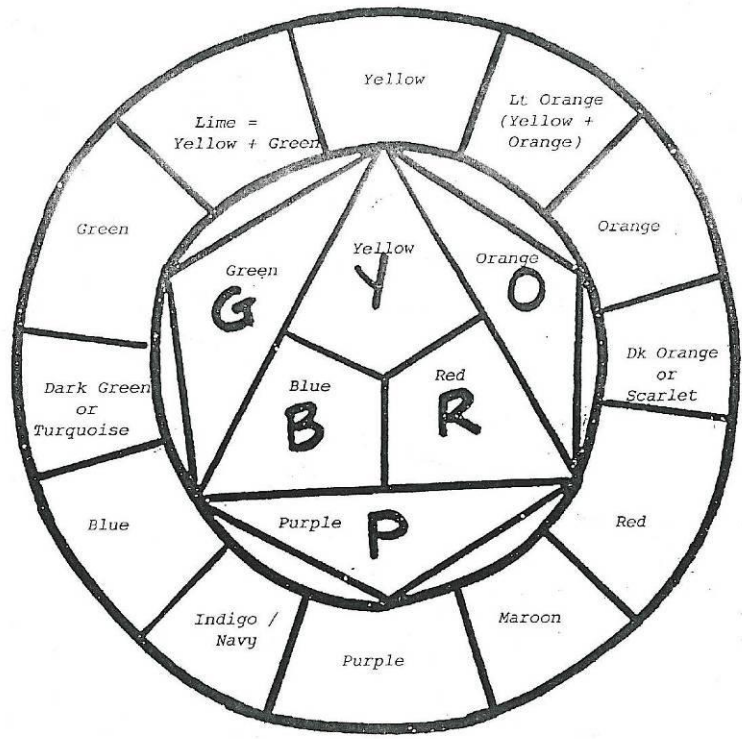
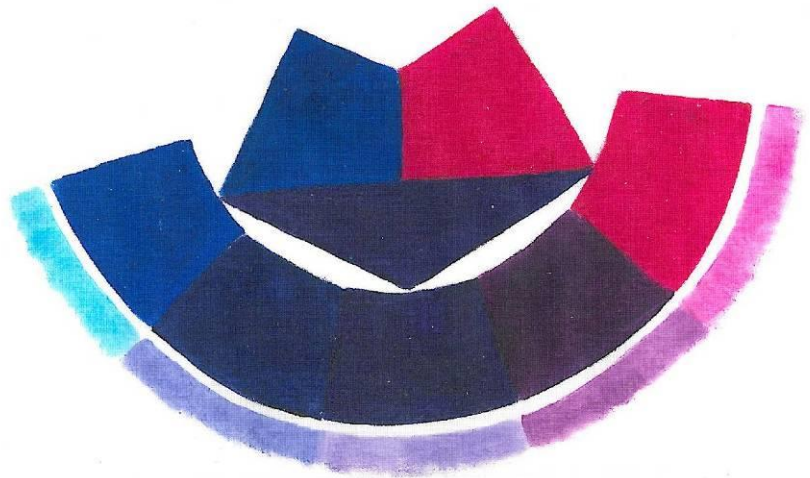

Transpose BLUE / RED / PURPLE section of the wheel, and paint again substituting MAGENTA in place of RED.

Start with YELLOW / BLUE / RED and create all other colours from these (Centre triangle)

- Primary Colours - yellow / blue / red
- Secondary Colours - green / orange / purple (Made by combining the pairs of Primary Colours)
- Tertiary Colours - made by combining primaryies and secondaries - see outer ring of Colour Circle.
- Analogous Colours - those which appear side by side on the Colour Circle - eg green / lime / yellow.
- Complementary Colours - those which appear at opposite sides of the Colour Circle - eg Yellow / Purple or Red / Green.

NOTE: The purple made by mixing blue and red is a very 'muddy' purple!
 To mix a clear, bright purple, combine blue with magenta.

When mixing colours , always start with the lightest colour in the palette and add the darker to it a little at a time.
