

Colour Mixing Guide



for *Liquid Radiance*

**Vibrant colours for use on all white or light coloured fabrics,
from Silk to Synthetics.**

*From our range of eight pure colours, it is possible to mix whatever colour you wish!
The colour range really becomes limitless !! The following colours are some of our 'favourites'*

To obtain the MIXED COLOUR:

- ◆ Mix [] parts PURE COLOUR (1) with [] parts PURE COLOUR (2), and add [] parts PURE COLOUR (3) where applicable. **Always start with the lighter colour/s in your palette or mixing vessel, then add the darker one/s a little at a time until you reach the required colour.**
- ◆ PARTS can be measured by counting drops from the dispenser cap, or 1 ml by eye dropper. Larger quantities can be mixed using a 10 ml medicine glass.

***Mixing BROWN - Any two complimentary colours, when mixed, will create brown: eg yellow + purple, red + green, blue + orange. Use the Colour Circle for reference, and check the note in bold print above. IMPORTANT: Liquid Radiance Green is a pure pigment colour, but is not the green required for mixing to make brown. Use a Secondary green, mixed with yellow and blue, then add red to it.**

Liquid Radiance colours are heat set by ironing. Use a heat setting suitable for the fabric on which you are working. For resist painting on silk, cover with a clean cloth (eg linen tea towel). For other fabrics, especially cottons, spray with water to make the task simpler. Iron for ½ to 2 minutes. The more diluted the colour, the longer you need to iron it.
