Making the Most of our Ideas and Techniques ... Liquid Radiance in Traditional Silk Painting Skills.

Many many years ago I became totally 'hooked' on silk painting !!! Having worked with dyes and steam fixing for several years, I thought to myself, "There has got to be something simpler for this". And when I couldn't find anything that met my 'wants', I set about satisfying that desire with the help of our Australian manufacturers. Yes, that's how Liquid Radiance was 'born'. Safe, simple, and economical – and without all the complications and toxicity of working with dyes! I wanted to make this beautiful skill something that EVERYONE could enjoy.

Traditional silk painting is all about the flow of colour within the lines (known as resist / gutta) that are applied and left to dry before continuing with the painting process. I soon found that practicing the flow on abstract shapes was a great way to develop my confidence, and I













recommend you do this too. Wavy lines were my favourites. You'll see this in Web Workshop 3 [ref Website Ed Centre, and on YouTube]. Without having to paint something specific, you have the freedom to practise with colours and colour mixing, as well as different techniques. I then started playing with overlapping squares and rectangles as you see in these samples. I thought they ended up looking a bit like buildings - I have called these "City Impressions". Soooo ...

• Play with the colours, diluted as per the videos - I start with equal parts LR concentrate and water, then add more water in the trays of the palette as required.

• Play with the different blending techniques and water texturing as well as drawing onto dry coloured base using a fine brush.

• Remember if working with salt in a picture like this, do those areas last – then rinse out the salt when the work is dry. Rinse pins and frame too so they don't spread saltiness to other work.

The completed 'picture' is on the frame at left. Mop-up result? Gone, sorry!

Now for the Palette Mop-Up ... images top to bottom at left below framed piece... palette with leftovers and piece of damp fabric ready to use, damp fabric folded to size and placed across the LR colours on palette, lifted off and rolled up to blend the colours, opened out on plastic with salt added for texturing (rock salt at top for big markings, Epsom salt at bottom for finer markings.)

Working from a palette like this doesn't HAVE to be a mop-up from other work! It's a very simple and quick way to colour the fabric when you want to create stripes. For larger fabrics, use a line-up of small dishes (eg plastic food containers), and put the diluted LR into those.

Whenever you are working with Liquid Radiance, remember to desalt as applicable, then heat set as usual. Need help? Phone or email me!
