## Making the Most of Our Painting Techniques ... More Palette Mop-Ups, the 'in-a-hurry' way!





After a recent Web Workshop in silk painting and being absolutely stretched for time! – doing something 'intelligent' to use up the colours on my palettes was simply not an option. And you KNOW I wouldn't waste them! So I drizzled a little more water over the left-overs and poured them into the dish to become ... well, whatever they became. The colour? A really deep bottle green (not true to colour in the images). From those meagre left-overs, I created two pieces of fabric and a pair of socks. A large piece of damp unbleached calico was coloured then sprinkled with pool salt. Socks were done next, and there

was STILL colour left! Grabbed the nearest piece of fabric (quite heavy headcloth) and coloured it without wetting the fabric first. The fascinating thing about mixing Liquid Radiance randomly like this is that the original colours will usually emerge somewhere during the drying

time, depending on how you fold it or scrunch it or salt it ... or whatever handling technique you use. I wish I could show you the actual fabrics in these pieces. There are pinkish / goldish / reddish bits popping up in the salted areas, and the cream/green/grey mottling on the headcloth is ... well, crazy

After all that, I need to let you know in advance that from 1<sup>st</sup> July '21 there will be a small price increase across our product range. We've been able to hold our prices for the past few years, but can do so no longer. Get in before 30<sup>th</sup> June if you'd like to beat that price rise!
