Silk Christmas Baubles These are a perennial favourite ... but we give them a new look using hand-coloured silk. **REQUIREMENTS:** Styrene foam balls - 50 mm or 65 mm Marking pen Scraps of coloured silk Coloured ribbon to match or contrast Sharp knife Beads Pearl headed pins 65 mm Ball Bias of fabric **METHOD:** Cut FOUR pattern pieces for each ball size, making sure you place the centre line on the bias of your silk. Use two colours that tone well and look good together. Using the seam line of the ball as a guide, place a rubber band so that it divides the ball in four equal portions. Mark these with a felt pen. Score along these lines with a sharp knife, Ball.

Using narrow coloured ribbon, hide the 'joins' in the ball. Secure the ribbon with pearl headed pins. For extra decorations, thread a couple of beads onto the shaft of the pin before pushing it into the ball.

Happy creating! ...

cutting about ½ cm into the styrene foam.

Place silk over the scored sections of the ball, and tuck in the edges using the knife to press them in.
