HANDS-ON – BASICS and BEYOND – Tuesday 9 April '24 "Safe, simple, and sustainable techniques for fabric designing in the classroom".

This full day workshop will contain all the elements from HEIA programs, but with four and a half hours to play instead of just an hour or two, there'll be plenty of time develop loads more skills and create a huge array of samples to inspire your students, then move on to the extensions with even more ideas and skills!

HANDS-ON - ADVANCED - Wednesday 10 April '24

On this day, techniques will include spray painting, stripey socks, upcycling garments, printing techniques and Liquid Lustres, simple batik, discharge techniques, and more. I shall custom build these two days to the needs and interests of participants.

OPTION – extend to Thursday 11 if participants would like to. Add extra \$50 to fee. It will be full steam ahead from the moment you arrive till you leave at 3.30 pm.

Starting out with using Liquid Radiance? Then Zoom into my Studio!

This is a continuous program, moving from morning topics to afternoon topics, covering similar information to the hands-on workshops above in **demonstration-style** presentations. Bookings for both sessions will take precedence over bookings for one session only. Participants are asked to enter the meeting room 10 to 15 minutes before start time to 'look around' and chat with other participants, and me. Everyone is muted during the demos, and invited to unmute after the presentation for questions and answers.

TO MAKE YOUR PLASTIC COVERED BOARDS

Making up the boards is usually something we do on the day during prep time, and takes about 15 to 20 minutes. For your workshop/s I'm aiming to fit in as much colouring prac as possible during our time together. Please prepare your boards BEFORE you arrive to save time on the day.

YOU WILL NEED:

Strong cardboard, masking tape Scissors – not 'good' ones

HOW TO:

- 1. Slide the cardboard into the plastic bag.
- 2. Fold over the edges of the plastic as if wrapping a flat parcel.
- 3. Seal the edges of the folds with masking tape completely to make it waterproof.
