OR you can simply have the day off. Your choice.

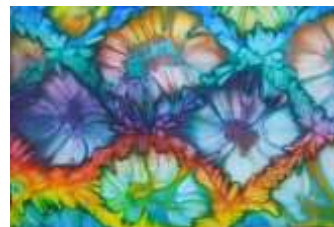
“Sensational Silk”

‘To Bring’ Lists – October 2024



TOP LIST: Bring to FABULOUS FABRICS WORKSHOPS ... Thu 17th and Fri 18th ...

- Lunch – tea and coffee provided
- Scissors (not your ‘good’ ones)
- Roll or pack of large plastic garbage bags
- Rubber gloves (preferably disposable)
- Plastic ice cream container (or similar water container)
- Roll of masking tape
- Three or four pieces of strong cardboard* approx 40 x 50 cms - sides of a carton are OK – covered* before you come
- FABRICS: white or light coloured plain fabric, any fibre – *minimum* 30 x 30 cm, up to 30 cm x 40 cm - 8 to 10 per day
- Notebook, pen, pencil
- Camera if you wish
- Old hand towel
- Old large towel
- Tissues or toilet roll
- Pins – pref with plastic heads

NOTE: Cotton fabrics should be washed to remove any sizing or dressing. Simply put them in a normal wash load, but do not use fabric softener. Similarly wash garments (socks, shirts) especially if they have been lurking in your wardrobe for some time! New socks do not need to be washed.

Top List PLUS THESE ITEMS for “Basics and Beyond” ... Thursday 17th October ...

- One pair of white or light coloured socks – washed if old
- Three plastic drink bottles, any shape or size – without drink in them!
- Cake cooling grid (not rack), or colander with large-ish holes, not slits
- Egg carton

Top List PLUS THESE ITEMS for “Big and Beautiful” ... Friday 18th October ...

- Two or three pieces of fabric between ½ metre and 2 metres in size – any fibre (cotton, polycotton, synthetic)
- Piece of polyester chiffon – approx ½ metre – white or any light colour
- Garments – t-shirts, blouses, undies, fabric shoes, hats – bring two or three items so you have a choice - old is OK!
- Piece of black fabric – cotton or polycotton - approx ¼ metre – not flimsy
- Old wire coat hanger or skirt hanger
- One or two new spray bottles with adjustable nozzles, preferably 500 ml size, but no bigger
- Piece of plumber’s pipe 10 to 15 cms diameter and approx 40 cms long
- Two large plastic covered boards* at least 50 cm x 60 cm – as big as you can fit into your car easily, laying them flat



THESE ITEMS ONLY for “Understanding Fabric Art” ... Saturday 19th October ...

- Lunch
- 6 pieces of fabric – white or pale coloured
- Old cotton or polycotton pillow case
- Scissors suitable for cutting fabric
- Rubber stamps (optional)
- Old hand towel

THESE ITEMS ONLY for “Metallics and Pearls” ... Sunday 20th October ...

- Lunch
- 1 metre of dark coloured fabric or black – any fibre, but not too flimsy or slippery!
- Old cotton or polycotton pillow case
- Scissors suitable for cutting fabric
- Old hand towel

THESE ITEMS ONLY for “Sensational Silk” ... Tue 22nd and Wed 23rd October ...

- Lunch
- Notebook, pen, and pencil (blunt)
- Old hand towel
- Two or three large plastic garbage bags
- Rubber gloves (optional)
- Scissors and pins
- Roll of masking tape
- Tissues or toilet roll

PLEASE WEAR: Comfortable old clothes, sandals or sneakers or joggers, and bring a hat.



TO MAKE YOUR PLASTIC COVERED BOARDS

Making up the boards is usually something we do on the day during prep time, and takes about 15 to 20 minutes. For your workshop/s I’m aiming to fit in as much colouring prac as possible during our time together. Please prepare your boards BEFORE you arrive to save time on the day.

YOU WILL NEED:

- Strong cardboard, masking tape
- Scissors – not ‘good’ ones

HOW TO:

1. Slide the cardboard into the plastic bag.
2. Fold over the edges of the plastic as if wrapping a flat parcel.
3. Seal the edges of the folds with masking tape completely to make it waterproof.
