# TOP LIST: Bring to FABULOUS FABRICS WORKSHOPS ... Wed 5<sup>th</sup> till Fri 7<sup>th</sup> ...

- Lunch tea and coffee provided
- Scissors (not your 'good' ones)
- Roll or pack of large plastic garbage bags
- Rubber gloves (preferably disposable)
- Plastic ice cream container (or similar water container)
- Roll of masking tape
- Three or four pieces of strong cardboard\* approx 40 x 50 cms sides of a carton are OK covered\* before you come
- FABRICS: white or light coloured plain fabric, any fibre minimum 30 x 30 cm, up to 30 cm x 40 cm 8 to 10 per day

NOTE: Cotton fabrics should be washed to remove any sizing or dressing. Simply put them in a normal wash load, but do not use fabric softener. Similarly wash garments (socks, shirts) especially if they have been lurking in your wardrobe for some time! New socks do not need to be washed.

#### Top List PLUS THESE ITEMS for "Two Day Workshop" ... Wednesday 5th and Thursday 6th August ...

- One pair of white or light coloured socks washed if old
- Plastic pipe eg plumbers' pipe 5 to 12 cm diameter, and at least 40 cms long (or a 1.5 or 2 litre drink bottle)
- Two plastic scrapers approx 10 to 15 cms wide (available from hardware stores tiling dept) OR two plastic rulers
- One or two new spray bottles pref 500 mls (no larger)
- White or light coloured blouse or t-shirt to upcycle

Old plastic or metal tray (eg scone tray)

Can of shaving foam (not gel or cream)

### Top List PLUS THESE ITEMS for "Big and Beautiful" ... Friday 7<sup>th</sup> August ...

- Two or three pieces of fabric between ½ metre and 2 metres in size any fibre (cotton, polycotton, synthetic)
- Piece of polyester chiffon approx ½ metre white or any light colour
- Garments t-shirts, blouses, undies, fabric shoes, hats bring two or three items so you have a choice - old or stained is good!
- Piece of black fabric cotton or polycotton approx ¼ metre not flimsy
- [ ] Large old towel
- Old wire coat hanger or skirt hanger
- One or two new spray bottles with adjustable nozzles, preferably 500 ml size, but no bigger
- Piece of plumber's pipe 10 to 15 cms diameter and approx 40 cms long
- Two large plastic covered boards\* at least 50 cm x 60 cm as big as you can fit into your car easily, laying them flat

#### THESE ITEMS ONLY for "Instant Fabrics in the Microwave" ... Saturday 8<sup>th</sup> August ...

- [ ] Lunch
- Two plastic-covered boards\* approx 30 x 40 cm
- Pins pref with plastic heads
- 100% cotton fabric white or light coloured 10 pieces 20 x 30 cms up to 30 x 40 cms calico, bleached calico, homespun, cotton poplin, ...
- Notebook and pen
- Camera if you wish
- Old hand towel
- Child's cotton t-shirt



PLEASE WEAR: Comfortable old clothes, sandals or sneakers or joggers, and bring a hat.

- One pair of black or navy socks washed if old
- [ ] Tissues or toilet paper ('craft paper')

- A selection of leaves with interesting vein patterns (pack between moist paper towel)
- A couple of pieces of mop-up fabric to use as backgrounds

# TO MAKE YOUR PLASTIC COVERED BOARDS for Fabulous Fabrics Workshops [See reverse of this page]

Making up the boards is usually something we do on the day during prep time, and takes about 15 to 20 minutes. For your workshop/s I'm aiming to fit in as much colouring prac as possible during our time together. Please prepare your boards BEFORE you arrive to save time on the day.

#### YOU WILL NEED:

Strong cardboard Scissors – not 'good' ones Masking tape

MASKING TAPE HINT: If your masking tape is a little old and cranky, and reluctant to come off the roll, pop it in the microwave for 10 seconds on high to rejuvenate it. Unroll it gently while it is still warm, but it should settle down happily when it is cool again. If this doesn't help, put it in the bin and buy more!

#### **HOW TO:**

- 1. Slide the cardboard into the plastic bag.
- 2. Fold over the edges of the plastic as if wrapping a flat parcel.
- Seal the edges of the folds with masking tape completely to make it waterproof.

ENTRANCE TO MY STUDIO is via the double garage (studio!) door in Wiemers Crescent. Door will be open around 15 minutes before workshop starts each day. In case of wet weather, come along the side path off the car tracks and enter via the back roller door. Please also note that our back patio tiles are slippery when it is wet, so wear shoes with non-slip soles. My Asics and Crocs shoes and sandals are safe on the patio in ANY weather ③.
